

An Introduction of Allama Qari Muhammad Muslehuddin Siddiqui Qadri



Hadrat Allama Hafiz Qari Muhammad Muslehuddin Qadri Rizwi was among one of those few who spread the light of the Message of Imam Ahmed Raza Khan Bareilvi in Karachi, Pakistan.

Early Life & Education:

He was born on RabiulAwwal 11, 1336H / December 27, 1917 in the Nanded District, Hyderabad Deccan, India. His Father Allama Ghulam Jilani was a prominent Scholar in Hyderabad Deccan. Qari Saheb took his early studies from a Local High School and completed the Hifz of Holy Quran from Allama Hafiz Aleem-ud-din AlaehRehma, a well-known scholar from his own family. He then travelled to Mubarakpur city situated in Azamgarh district, India where he studied Dars-e-Nizami from a Leading Scholar of the time, Allama Hafiz Abdul Aziz Mubarakpuri at Al-Jamiat-ul-Ashrafiya which was too founded by Qari Saheb's beloved Allama Hafiz Abdul Aziz Saheb Mubarakpuri.

Qari Saheb took ba'iat in the Spiritual Chain of Qadriyah Rizwiyah at the age of 21 on the hands of Sadru-sh-Shariah Allama Amjad Ali Aazmi, the Khalifa / Spiritual Successor of Imam Ahmed

Raza Khan Fazil-e-Barelvi from whom he was later given the Khilafa / Permissions of the Spiritual Chain Qadriyah Rizwiyah during a Mehfil-e-Naat in Nagpur when Hadrat Qari Saheb recited a Famous Naat written by Molana Jami AlaehRehma in his sweet voice which brought tears in the eyes of all the participants and Allama Amjad Ali Aazmi as well.

Qari Saheb was also given Khilafah / Permission of Qadriyah Rizwiyah order as well as number of other Sufi Orders by Allama Zia-ud-din Ahmed Madani, the Qutb of Madinatul-Munawwara and Mufti-e-Azam Hind Mufti Muhammad Mustafa Raza Khan. After the militant occupation by Indian Government of the State of Hyderabad Deccan, Allama Qari Muhammad Muslehuddin Siddiqui migrated to Karachi, Pakistan in 1949 where he started preaching Maslak-e-Alahazrat.



Services to the Religion & Maslak-e-Alahazrat:

He led the Prayers and Acted as Speaker at the historic Akhund Masjid which is located adjacent to the Birth Place of the Founder of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah in Kharadar, Karachi for almost 19 years. During this period, he also took such responsibility for about a year in the Central Masjid of Wah Cantt, Rawalpindi where about almost 20,000 people used to perform Friday prayer after him and people were weeping and very emotional when he had to left that Masjid after a year to re-join the Akhund Masjid, Kharadar on continuous requests by the people of Karachi.

Meanwhile, he was approached by the Committee Members of Memon Masjid Muslehuddin (formerly Khori) Garden, Karachi to took the responsibility of Prayer and Speaker at such a big Masjid where he would be able to perform the service to the religious cause with more facility. He then started leading prayer and speeches here in Memon Masjid Muslehuddin (formerly Khori) Garden which was later named after him as Memon Masjid Muslehuddin Garden.

He remained associated with Dar-ul-Uloom Amjadia, one of the famous educational center of AhleSunnah in Karachi, as a teacher till one year before he left this world.

Followers & Successors:

It was because of his efforts that the Love of Prophet Alaehissalato Wassalam enlightened among his Thousands of followers which included number of scholars who later became the leading figures of AhleSunnah. The Most Prominent of them is his Son in Law and Spiritual Successor As-Sheikh Allama Syed Shah Turab-ul-Haq Qadri Al-Jilani Noori and Allama Mufti Abdul Aziz Hanfi Saheb.

He delivered his Khilafah / Permissions of Qadriyah Rizwiyah and other Sufi orders to Allama Syed Shah Turab-ul-Haq Qadri (Ameer of Jamaat-e-AhleSunnat Pakistan, Karachi) and Allama Abdul Azeem Qadri (Bangladesh). At present, His GrandSon Allama Syed Shah Abdul Haq Qadri Al-Jilani Noori is the current custodian of His Spiritual Chain.

On the 7th day of Jumada al-Thani 1403 AH, corresponding to March 23, 1983, at noon, he felt ill, and started to recite Kalimah and Durood and left this world in the ambulance en route to the hospital due to a heart attack at the age of 67 years. Thousands of people attended his funeral Prayers, which was led by Mufti Muhammad Akhtar Raza Khan Barelvi. His Shrine is located adjacent to the same Memon Masjid Muslehuddin Garden, Karachi where he served the AhleSunnah till his last time.



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
